As an Instructor of our one of our PianoLabs, you will play an essential role in bringing piano music to K-8 students in the Cleveland Metropolitan School District. You will deliver group piano instruction to beginner Cleveland Metropolitan School District students using the digital Roland Piano Lab system.



RESPONSIBILITIES

Lead successful launch (March 2026) and execution of new PianoLab program at an Eastside CMSD school, by:

- Teaching 50-minute group piano lessons to up to ten students at a time, four times per week
- Delivering a mutually agreed upon curriculum to students in an engaging and age-appropriate manner
- Differentiating piano instruction among younger and older students
- Ensuring instrument technology functions appropriately, and troubleshooting tech issues that may arise

Collaborate with Education & Community Engagement Lead to ensure successful completion of the program by:

- Assisting in building and overseeing evaluation criteria to measure program impact
- Assisting in planning and execution of end-of-program assessment for student participants

- Lessons are 50-minutes each and held four times per week, during the following times:

 - Thursdays from 8:25- 9:15 AM
 - Fridays from 8:25- 9:15 AM
- Teacher should plan to arrive no later than 30 minutes before the start of each lesson
- Fall schedule is subject to change after Spring 2026, but number of lessons would remain the same
